#### **RFI SUBMISSION DATE:**

The RFI submission due date has changed from **Thursday, July 3, 2025**, to **Thursday, July 17, 2025**, time remains same.

#### **QUALIFIED PROVIDERS' QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES:**

Question	Response
1. If a company doesn't respond fully to this RFI are we precluded from bidding on the RFP that is expected in FY 26?	No, your firm will be eligible to participate in the RFP process if your firm do not respond to this RFI. However, if your firm can provide information, please submit it by July 17, 2025.



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2. Does the District require low bid in its procurement or are they able to consider best-value or other selection criteria?	PGCPS will issue an RFP resulting from information obtained from RFI responses received. A contract will be awarded to offeror(s) on the basis of best-value against defined criteria's.
3. What are the district's intentions of owning the system vs. utilizing a third-party ownership model / power purchase agreement?	At this time, the District is open to exploring various solar PV ownership models.
4. Are respondents required to be prequalified under the Maryland DGS ESCO list to respond?	No.
5. I am an energy analyst. I am reaching out with regard to the PGCPS Renewable Energy Development Solar Photovoltaic System RFI. I noticed a lot of site-specific questions in the Technical Capabilities and Costing Information sections, but there are not any sites listed to do any site-specific designs or models for. I'm assuming those sections pertain to what is expected in a submission to an RFP rather than the RFI? If you could help clarify what exactly is expected in a submission response for this RFI, that would be greatly appreciated.	All proposed sites are not finalized at this time. The current portfolio of locations is veritable in size/age and "may" also involve a new roof. These will mainly be K-12 schools or former schools that are now utilized for admin purposes. Information "may" also be utilized for new construction opportunities. Perhaps consider your company's capabilities for all types of solar (rooftop, ground array, canopy).
6. My firm is excited to be participating in the PGCPS RFI. I'm reaching out because I have not been able to access the additional documents through either link provided. Could you resend that information so I can kick off diligence with my team?
