

What did we learn?



- 74.7% of students felt that their community school always welcomes everyone.
- 16.5% of students felt that there was someone at the school who could provide hearing, vision and dental services.

- 67.2% of families felt that the school helps them and their families feel included.
- 64.1% of families feel that students have access to school field trips, after-school programs, or summer programs.



- 87% of staff fe
- 87% of staff feel that students have access to school field trips, after-school programs, or summer programs.
- 47.6% of the staff identified food insecurity as an area of need for students.

- 91.7% of partners shared that they felt welcome at the school.
- 66.7% of partners describe the quality of relationships between families, partners, community agencies, and the school as very strong.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous,

and Expanded, Enriched
Learning Opportunities

Expand after-school programming to include STEM-based learning opportunities, increase literacy-focused enrichment activities, and provide targeted tutoring support for students requiring academic intervention. Leverage existing partnerships to integrate tutoring services and enhance field trip experiences to reinforce and extend classroom learning.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice Increase meaningful involvement of parents and students in planning and decision-making by developing student council structures; establishing PTO and collaborating with local leaders.





Expand access to wraparound services addressing mental health, legal, and basic needs for families by partnering with health providers, hosting monthly service connection events and strengthening referral systems.

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care



Continue fostering a welcoming environment for the school community by expanding outreach efforts and developing additional strategies to effectively communicate opportunities for engagement.

Powerful Student and Family Engagement



Improve accessibility, flexibility, and cultural relevance of family engagement efforts by offering virtual and evening workshops; providing child care and expanding partnerships for adult classes and outreach.
