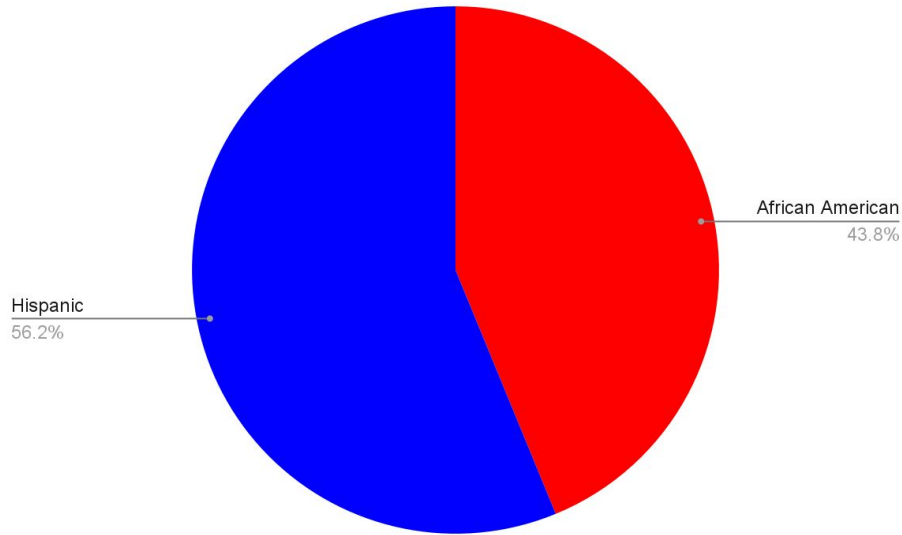
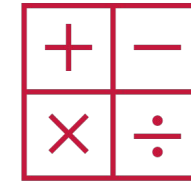

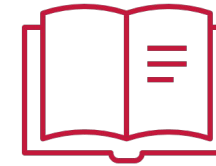

Student Feedback

- Students indicate that they would like additional mental health and social-emotional support.

Staff Feedback

- 100% of the staff expressed that the school culture is always positioned to make families, students, and community partners feel a sense of belonging, safety, and care.
- Many staff reported that they have access to leadership opportunities.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Allenwood Elementary School plans to focus on continuing and expanding programming for after-school programs to provide support in several areas (i.e. academics, arts and music, social, emotional, and behavioral health, etc.). The school will also find opportunities to use funding to provide students with more field trips and academic enrichment opportunities. Finally, community school funds will be allocated to fund materials for programming and student incentives to support academic excellence and attendance increase.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



Connect and leverage students, families, and community members who would like to actively participate in opportunities to lead and volunteer within the school and remove barriers that may prevent them from participating. Allenwood Elementary School plans to be intentional about extending leadership opportunities to our extended communities through the Steering Committee, Parents and others Assisting Wildcats (P.A.W. Partners) and volunteer opportunities.

Integrated Systems of Support



Allenwood Elementary School will utilize community school funds to create other student services positions and partner with vendors to provide services to meet the needs of students and families. Additionally, the school will seek to establish and strengthen collaboration with local organizations to provide our school community access to mental and behavioral health opportunities, education, and resources for students and families..
