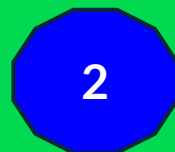

What did we learn?



- **61.2%** of respondents indicated the school always or sometimes helps them and their family feel included.
- **32.7%** of respondents indicated that Baden never offers students chances to help make decisions at the school.



- All respondents (**100%**) agreed that the school offers integrated systems of support to students and families.
- **25%** of respondents indicated that Baden always or sometimes offers field trips, after-school programs, or summer programs for students.



- **83.4%** of respondents indicated that they or the student can always or sometimes get extra help with learning and schoolwork if needed
- **31.4%** of respondents indicated that Baden always or sometimes offers field trips, after-school programs, or summer programs for students.
- Current partners are willing to continue to assist the Baden school community as needed.
- Some partners are currently unaware to the extent of rigorous, community-connected classroom instruction and expanded, enriched learning opportunities are available.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Project-based learning tied to local needs. Invite community experts to co-teach or guest speak on relevant topics.

Addressing low math proficiency and reading gaps with tailored support.

Field trips to extend learning.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



Host family leadership/advocacy events to co-create school improvement strategies.

Select students to welcome guests, lead tours, or help during events.

Invite families to lead sessions and workshops based on their skills.

Integrated Systems of Support



Provide informal behavior support plans with check-in/check-out, with daily goal tracking, and an adult mentor who meets the student each morning and afternoon.

Partner with local mental health providers.

Host a resource fair at the school featuring local partners.

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care



Multilingual family nights providing translators and interpreters.

Daily intentional positive phone calls home.

Student shout-out boards.

Powerful Student and Family Engagement



Increase outreach efforts to families through personalized invitations and clear explanations of how attending school events supports student success.

Regularly communicate available support services to families.
