


What did we learn?



- Students want more opportunities to engage in sports, recreational activities, after-school clubs, as well as field trips.
- Various student groups indicated interest in more outdoor time during school hours and food/snacks as incentives.
- School safety is a concern amongst different student groups.



- Teachers and staff agree students need support with reading & math.
- · Social, emotional, and behavioral support, as well as access to community resources.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



Cherokee Lane Elementary School Community School plans to strengthen and expand its after-school programs to support students in a variety of areas, including academics, the arts, music, and social-emotional and behavioral development. The school also aims to explore creative ways to combine funding sources to increase access to field trips and academic enrichment experiences. Additionally, Community School funds will be used to purchase materials to enhance programming and provide student incentives.
