School Report Card - State Level

Samuel Ogle is a 3-Star school with a percentage rating increase of 4.5% needed in SY 25 to be a 4-Star School. It is our Mission and Vision to be a 5-Star school by the end of SY 2027. Gains are made in multiple categories of school performance. Data points are from the SY 24 assessment scoring and we are at the beginning of the SY 25 Administration of MCAP, which will begin in April.

Mental Health Clinician -

By referral and parental consent, we offer opportunities for students to work with an Art Therapist, who is on staff full time, to provide support to students who are in need of expressing themselves through art form and individual counseling services.

This was a new position introduced to PGCPS during SY 21- 22 for the benefit of students returning to in-person learning following the pandemic.
