

What did we learn?



- Culture: Students reported a positive and inclusive school climate. Many students feel they can be honest with adults and see their culture reflected at school.
- Relationships: Many students feel they can be honest with adults at school.
- **Culture:** Families are actively engaged in school and community events.
- **Communication:** Families prefer direct communication and feel academic info is accessible and clearly shared in their language.



- Culture: Staff reported a positive and inclusive school climate
- **Relationships:** Staff report strong participation in school and community events



- Communication: Reported that the school communicates clearly and keeps them engaged in supporting students.
- Well-Being: Reported that the school prioritizes student well-being through strong support programs and caring staff

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous. Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunites =

- Integrate community resources and partnerships into lesson planning. Use culturally responsive teaching practices that reflect students'
- backgrounds.
- Offer after-school enrichment programs focused on arts, STEM, and languages.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



- Develop leadership capacity among teachers, students, and families.
- Encourage open communication and feedback loops.
- Celebrate and amplify voices from underrepresented groups, such as students with disabilities and multilingual learners.

Integrated Systems of Support



- Ensure accessibility of support services to all students and families.
- Coordinate with community agencies for wraparound services.
- Build multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS) to address diverse needs, such as PBIS.

- Address bullying, discrimination, and bias proactively.
- Support staff and student well-being and mental health.
